### Ofsted

As you are aware, Ofsted visited us on 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> July. We were provided with some verbal feedback on the day. The report will be sent to school within 18 days for us to check, and then it will be published. Due to timelines, it will likely be September before we can share this with you. Your children were amazing, and we were as proud of them as we always are.

### Reports

The children's reports will be handed out to them on Friday 12<sup>th</sup> July. Enclosed will also be the letter informing you of the class that your child will be in next year.

### SAT's Results

The Year 6 have sat their end of KS2 assessments and the results of these will also be included in the report.

The children are assessed in Reading, Writing, Maths, GPS (Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling) and Science. There is also a combined result. If your child has achieved this at age expected, it means that they have achieved age expected in Reading, Writing and Maths.

The results sheet provides you with the scaled score that your child achieved and the standard that this relates to in regard to age expectation.

In Science children have either met the standard or have not met the standard.

On the reverse of the results sheet there is a table that shows the schools results as a percentage and how that compares to national percentages.

## Children in Year 2

At the end of Year 2, the government entitlement to Universal Free School Meals ends and parents of these children start to pay for their school meal. We would like to bring to your attention the possibility of eligibility for Free School Meals Funding. Even if you do not believe you qualify, we encourage you to apply as the process is quick and straightforward, you just need your national insurance number to apply.
