I just wanted to update you on some exciting plans we are currently working on as a school. To this end, we have currently put in an application for grant funding to open a wraparound provision – provisionally from March if the application is successful. We are also working on an application for a possible nursery provision within our school. If successful, the nursery provision would be open for 3 year olds from September 2025. Although we do not know the outcome of these applications yet, I wanted to share this with you. I will update you as soon as I know more.
